Proposed 20mph Zone: Brinsmead Road Area

Leicester City Council is proposing to introduce a 20mph zone in the Brinsmead Road area. This is part of our commitment to improve road safety and encourage walking and cycling near to schools and in residential areas.

Currently, the speed limit on these streets is 30mph and it is proposed to reduce this to 20mph. Leicester City Council is proposing to install traffic calming on Brinsmead Road and Church Lane, where speed surveys have shown speeding issues and there is a record of recorded personal injury collisions. No traffic calming is proposed on other roads in the area. The proposals are shown on the maps enclosed with this letter. Further information is available over the page.

The Council would like to hear your views on these matters.

1. The proposed speed limit change will affect the following streets:

- 2. The proposed speed cushions can be overridden by ambulances, fire tenders and buses. These cushions are manufactured from recycled shredded tyres.
- 3. It is estimated that the cost of the scheme will be around £20,000.
- 4. If this proposal is approved, then the change is likely to come into force in early 2025.
