BRADING ROAD AREA - PROPOSED 20MPH ZONE

Leicester City Council is proposing to introduce a 20mph zone in the Brading Road area. This is part of our commitment to improve road safety and encourage walking and cycling near to schools and in residential areas.

At the moment, the speed limit on these streets is 30 miles per hour and it is proposed to reduce this to 20 miles per hour. Leicester City Council is proposing to install traffic calming on Buckminster Road where speed surveys have shown speeding issues. No traffic calming measures are currently proposed on the other roads in the area. The proposals are shown on the maps enclosed with this letter. Further information is available over the page.

The Council would like to hear your views on these matters.
