GLENGARRY WAY AREA - PROPOSED 20MPH ZONE

Leicester City Council is proposing to introduce a 20mph Zone in the Glengarry Way Area. This is part of our commitment to improve road safety and encourage walking and cycling near to schools and in residential areas.

At the moment, the speed limit on these streets is 30 miles per hour and it is proposed to reduce this to 20 miles per hour. Leicester City Council is not currently proposing to install any traffic calming measures on any roads in this area. The proposals are shown on the map enclosed with this letter. Further information is available over the page.

The Council would like to hear your views on these matters.

Your response will be included in a report on the proposals which goes to the City Mayor who will decide whether to go ahead with the proposed changes or not.

Further Information - Proposed 20mph Zone for the Glengarry Way Area

1. The proposed speed limit change will affect the following streets:

Glengarry Close	Whole length
Glengarry Court	Whole length
Glengarry Way	Whole length
Greencoat Road	Whole length
Perth Avenue	From its junction with Glengarry Way to its cul-de-sac end
Piper Close	Whole length
Piper Way	Whole length
St Oswalds Road	Whole length
The Ridgeway	Whole length

2. It is estimated that the cost of the scheme will be around £25,000.
3. If this proposal is approved, then the change is likely to come into force in spring 2025.
