Proposed 20mph Zone: St Josephs & Netherhall

Leicester City Council is proposing to introduce a 20mph zone in the St Josephs & Netherhall area. This is part of our commitment to improve road safety and encourage walking and cycling near to schools and in residential areas.

Currently, the speed limit on these streets is 30mph and it is proposed to reduce this to 20mph. Leicester City Council is proposing to install traffic calming features on Wigley Road, Armadale Drive, Moorfields and New Romney Crescent. This is where speed surveys have shown speeding issues and there is a record of recorded personal injury collisions. No traffic calming is proposed on other roads in the area. The proposals are shown on the maps enclosed with this letter. Further information is available over the page.

The Council would like to hear your views on these matters.
