HUMBERSTONE VILLAGE – PROPOSED 20MPH ZONE.

The Leicester City Council is writing to you about a change in the speed limit for your street.

At the moment, the speed limit in Humberstone Village is 30 miles per hour and, following requests for a 20mph speed limit, the Council is proposing a 20 miles per hour speed limit for the area. The proposals are shown on the map enclosed with this letter.

The Council would like to hear your views on these matters.



Proposed 20 mph zone for Humberstone Village

1. This proposed change will affect the following streets:

2. There are existing advisory School Keep Clear Markings outside both Humberstone Infant School and Humberstone Junior School. It is proposed to invoke a Traffic Regulation Order to make these markings mandatory so that enforcement can be carried out.
3. These proposed changes are part of a programme of new 20mph zones which was confirmed by the Deputy City Mayor on 12th June 2012. Money has been set aside by the Council from the Integrated Capital Programme to pay for these changes. It is estimated that the cost of the scheme will be £10,000
4. If this proposal is approved, then the scheme is likely to be implemented in the late summer of 2014.
