QUAKESICK VALLEY – PROPOSED 20MPH ZONE.

Leicester City Council is proposing to introduce a 20 MPH Zone in Quakesick Valley. This will involve a change the speed limit to 20 miles per hour and installation of a road hump on Bellflower Road to constrain speeds and discourage through traffic.

The developer of housing in this area is funding the proposed scheme and there is no cost to Leicester City Council. The proposal is shown on the map enclosed with this letter. If you would like further information please see over the page.

The Council would like to hear your views on these matters.
