Top tips to get your child reading

- 1 Read to your child** – reading starts with listening. Read to your child as much as you can. You're never too old or too young to share a book together.
- 2 Read anywhere and everywhere** – take a book out with you, read signs, posters and logos. The world of words is all around you.
- 3 Don't just read books** – read anything – newspapers, comics, magazines, e-mails and mobile texts.
- 4 Be positive** – praise your child for their reading. It's alright to make mistakes; that's how we learn!
- 5 You read too** – children love to copy adults. Set a good reading example for your child and show them you like to read too.
- 6 Chat** – talk about what is inside the book. Ask what it is about, what might happen next, who's in it and what they did. Use pictures as a starting point for a conversation.
- 7 Little and often** – a happy 10 minutes reading is better than a difficult struggle for half an hour.
- 8 Libraries** – nowhere has as many books and as much reading choice for free as your local library – use it!
- 9 Choose books carefully** – follow your child's interests. Choose some shorter, easier reading for your child to feel confident and relax with. Have some longer choices to tackle together.
- 10 Fun! Fun! Fun!** We all learn more when we are enjoying ourselves.
