

Review of Polling Districts, Polling Places and Polling Stations

Guidelines and further information

The following considerations have been taken into account when allocating polling districts and polling places. Comments made during the consultation should keep these in mind.

- Ideally, the polling place should be in its own polling district.
- No polling place should be shared by two wards.
- Where possible, “natural” boundaries should be used for polling districts e.g. railways, major roads, etc.
- All properties in a minor road or estate should, ideally, be in the same polling district.
- Polling places should be “logical”; that is, electors should not have to pass another polling place to get to their own
