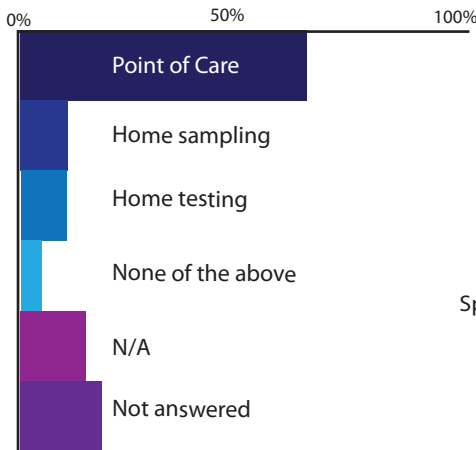

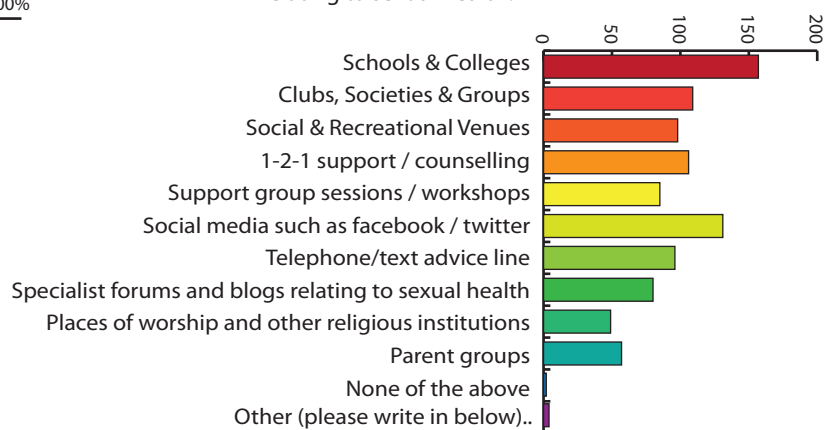

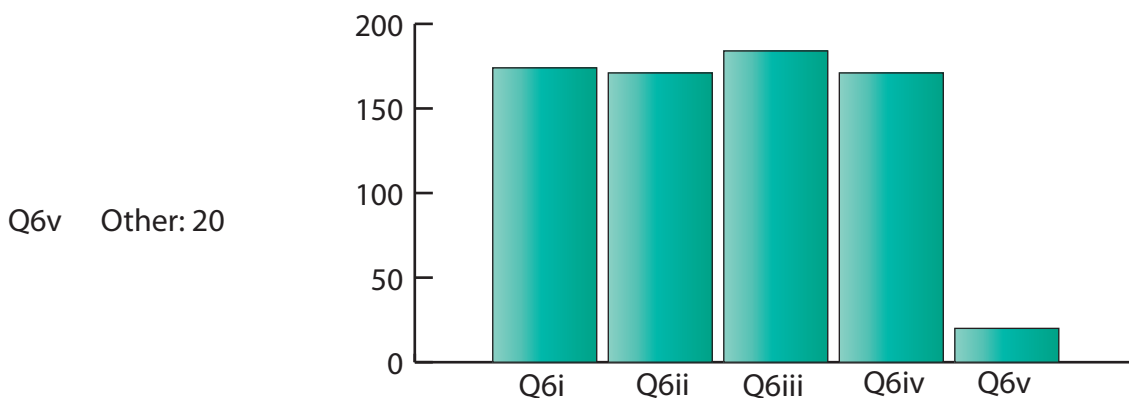
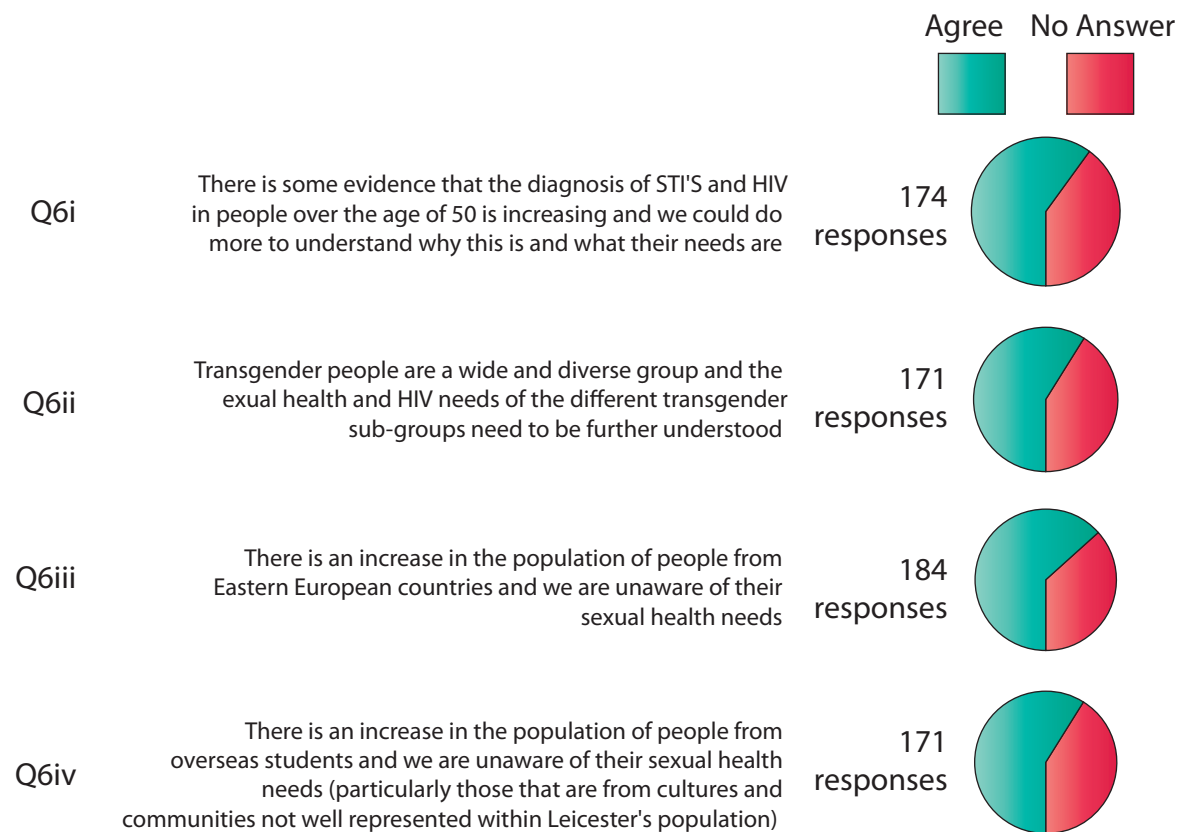


Question 6: Emerging Groups

Please indicate if you agree with the statement, and if you can think of any more emerging groups that need to be considered, please list them and tell us why in the space provided



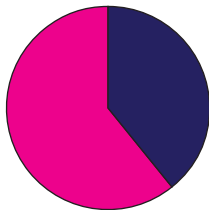
