

Re-organisation of Nether Hall Special School

Notice is given in accordance with The School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013 that Leicester City Council intends to make prescribed alterations to the Nether Hall Special School Keyham Lane West LE5 1RT with effect from 1st September 2021.

This expansion will be achieved by the refurbishment of Armadale Centre Grantham Road, Leicester, LE5 1HR. This expansion will become the satellite site for the main school.

It is proposed to change the number on roll of Nether Hall Special School, from its current number on roll of 110 to 140. The current number of pupils registered at the school is 108.

There will be a group of approx. 30 pupils aged 14 and above who will be based at the new centre. This will allow pupils with specific needs access to the specialist facilities at the main site and the more complex learners opportunities to be in a more vocational / PfA (Preparing for Adulthood) setting. The same Governing Body and Senior Leadership Team will oversee the new site.

Statutory consultation requirements relating to this proposal have been complied with.
