

DSVA services for Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland (current)

Referrals in (including self-referrals)

DSVA LLR Support and Information Service (age 13 years +)

The **helpline service** is an integral part of the current LLR DSVA support and information service. It is freephone and accredited by the Helpline Partnership Association. There is also a business line and a textphone service as entry points to onward provision.

LLR IDVA

Independent Domestic Violence Advisors (specific qualification) support victims assessed as being at high risk of death or injury.

LLR ISVA

Independent Sexual Violence Advisors (specific qualification) support victims who have experienced sexual assault.

LLR Counselling

Network of specialist counselling providers provide individual counselling, generally for 12 weeks although longer is available.

LLR Outreach & Recovery

Provide practical and emotional support individually or in groups.

Other provision not in scope of review

Conditional Cautions and Relationship Abuse (CARA)

Out of court disposal primarily for first time / low level offenders.

LLR Child Independent Sexual Violence Advisors (CHISVAs)

Supporting child victims of sexual assault (under 13 years of age).

LLR DV360 – Assertive Outreach

Based with Police. Contracted by PCC. Visit and support repeat victims of DA not high risk.

Housing related support

Leicester service - refuge and general housing support for victims fleeing DSVA. Moves for perpetrators if in the victims best interest and committed to change

Leicestershire service - refuge provision.

Children, Young People and Families Service

Leicester service - works with children affected by DSVA and their non-abusing parent/carer. Preventative and recovery. Respite and creche.

Domestic violence perpetrator interventions

Leicester service - works with men and women with no court involvement who wish to change their abusive behaviour.

Acronyms and colour coding

DSVA = Domestic and sexual violence or abuse

DA = Domestic abuse

LLR = Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland

UAVA = United Against Violence and Abuse

PCC = Police and Crime Commissioner for Leicestershire
