FROLESWORTH ROAD AREA - PROPOSED 20MPH ZONE

Leicester City Council is proposing to introduce a 20mph zone in the Frolesworth Road area. This is part of our commitment to improve road safety and encourage walking and cycling near to schools and in residential areas.

At the moment, the speed limit on these streets is 30 miles per hour and it is proposed to reduce this to 20 miles per hour. Leicester City Council is not currently proposing to install any traffic calming measures on any roads in this area. The proposals are shown on the map enclosed with this letter. Further information is available over the page.

The Council would like to hear your views on these matters.

2. It is estimated that the cost of the scheme will be around £8,000.
3. If this proposal is approved, then the change is likely to come into force in spring 2024.
