Ashton Green – Traffic Calming Consultation

Leicester City Council is proposing to carry out traffic calming works and implement speed restrictions on Ashton Green Road in support of the Ashton Green development.

The works will support the new Morris Homes development and future housing at Ashton Green. The proposals include a 20 mph (currently 30 mph) speed restriction to Ashton Green Road (formerly Leicester Road), between Greengate Lane and the Bevan Road roundabout and 30 mph restriction, (currently 60 mph) to Ashton Green Road north of Bevan Road to Thurcaston.

The works on-site will include temporary speed cushions to the Morris Homes frontage, eventually to be replaced with permanent raised tables post construction completion. Also included will be further cycle/footway improvements and new street lighting north of Bevan Road.

These proposals are part of the wider programme of transport measures in support of the Ashton Green development, that have already included improved cycling and walking links between the development and the Beaumont Shopping Centre.

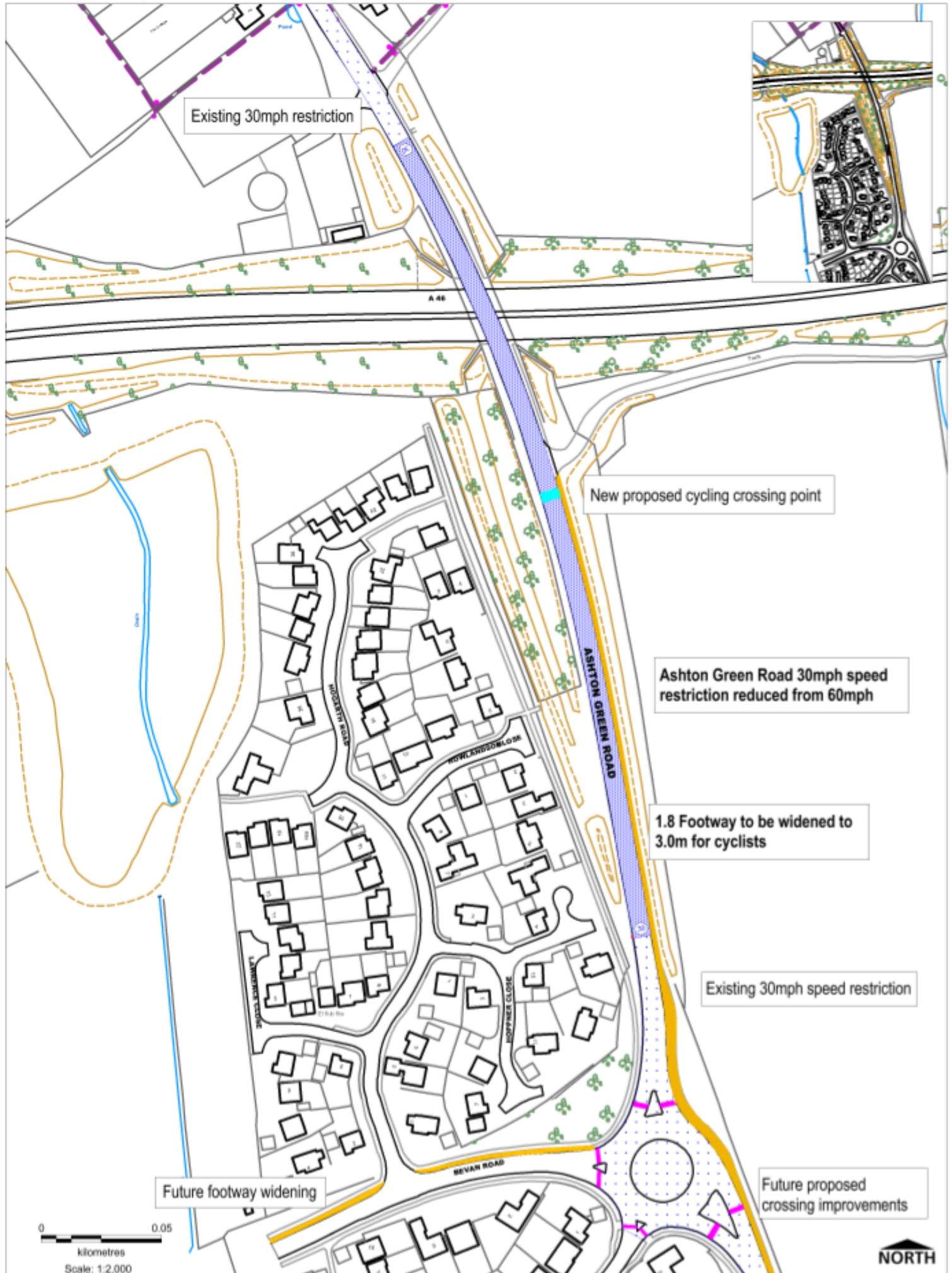
Plan 1- New 20mph section of Ashton Green Road and proposed location of temporary speed cushions
